NGĀTI TAMATERĀ – PARE HAURAKI COLLECTIVE TREATY SETTLEMENT

Tēnā ra koutou e Ngāti Tamaterā

The mandated Treaty negotiators for Ngāti Tamaterā, alongside the other Iwi of Hauraki, have negotiated a collective Treaty settlement with the Crown. The Crown offer is contained in the Pare Hauraki Collective Redress Deed.

The collective settlement reflects shared customary interests of the Iwi of Hauraki and our whanaungatanga and kotahitanga to each other. The Collective Redress Deed is an important element of the settlement of the Ngāti Tamaterā historical Treaty claims, which is imminent.

The documentation provided in this voting pack is also available on the Ngāti Tamaterā website www.tamatera.co.nz. It will assist you to make informed ratification decisions. There will also be ratification information hui that you may want to attend.

The people of Ngāti Tamaterā can now vote on whether to support the Pare Hauraki Collective Redress Deed and the Collective entities that need to be set up to receive this redress. The settlement is never going to reinstate all that was lost but we believe it provides a solid base for the cultural, social and economic revitalisation of Ngāti Tamaterā.

We believe the Crown's offer represents the best offer available and we endorse the collective redress and strongly support voting yes to both resolutions.
